Ukrainian refugees will get a special protection status in Austria. This includes the possibility to work, the right to go to school, free medical services, and a monthly payment of a moderate amount of money for food. (Until the special protection status will be passed by the Austrian Parliament, Ukrainian citizens can enter Austria with a passport and stay in the country 'for touristic purposes'.)

When you arrive to Austria, please go to one of the reception centres or to the local community ('Meldeamt' – registration office)
